

Building Trinity – What We are Doing

On May 9, 2011, *Miller Construction* began the Fellowship Hall Renovation Project. It is expected to span the better part of three months. Painting and installation of floor coverings is anticipated to be completed in August and we should be able to enjoy our Fellowship Hall again by the beginning of the new School Year in September.

The Project:

- Removal of existing floor.
- Tiling of the foundation.
- Updating of the sewer pipes.
- Installation of in-floor heating system.
- Installation of new floor.
- Removal of existing radiators.
- Relocating the nursery from the southwest corner to the front of the Fellowship Hall, behind the Altar.
- Moving the altar out from its existing location to allow space for the new nursery.
- Remodeling the old nursery into storage.
- Remodeling of the bathroom in the south entrance to the Fellowship Hall into two handicapped accessible bathrooms.
- Repainting of the walls.
- Installing new floor coverings.

During construction, activities normally scheduled for the Fellowship Hall will be moved to other areas within the facility or will take place off site.

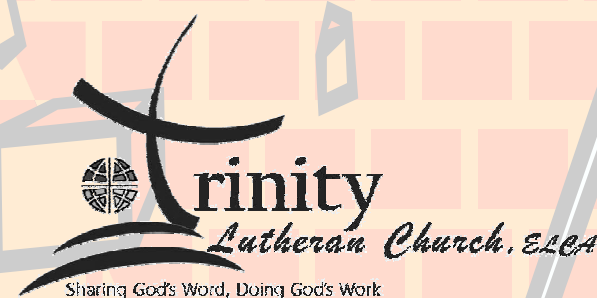
The total project has an estimated cost of just over \$100,000.

Building Trinity – What Can You Do?

- Friends! Think of the many friendships you have developed here at Trinity. It may be the friends you sit with during worship, have coffee with or your neighbors. A group of friends could get together to help us make a payment.

After all, the main purpose of the Fellowship Hall is bringing people together.

After you or your group has committed to help us make a payment, it still might not be as simple as writing a check. We do have five years to pay for this, so you may want to spread your commitment over a period of time. You may want to consider spreading you commitment over several months or years to make it easier. Consider the following creative ideas as you prayerfully consider your commitment:

- Have a rummage sale, car wash, bake sale, or special event with a portion of the proceeds going towards your commitment.
- Simply save your loose change, gather it up periodically and apply it to your commitment.
- Set a goal of putting aside \$2 a day and apply this weekly or monthly toward your commitment.

We will offer recognition for all gifts on the Trinity Fellowship Quilt to be displayed in Fellowship Hall.
