Dear Trinity Family,

I have always found it helpful to think of the Lenten season as a journey. Mirroring Jesus' time in the wilderness, we devote forty days to self-examination, contemplation, and transformation. We get an early start to our Lenten journey this year, as Ash Wednesday falls on February 18<sup>th</sup>. Lent is a time for us to take a close look at ourselves, as individuals and as a community, and to identify the things that might be preventing us from fully living as God's people, and then to make changes to our practices and habits to help us grow and flourish. This is challenging work, but critical to a life of faith.

In his life and ministry, Jesus demonstrated qualities like healing, forgiveness, mercy, and compassion. Take a look around. In our world today, it is often difficult to see these values and characteristics Jesus modeled for us. Where have they gone? How have we become so divided, callous, even cruel? Beginning on Ash Wednesday, we will be reading a book called *Good and Beautiful and Kind* by Rich Villodas. In this book, Villodas offers "a compelling vision of wholeness for broken lives and a fractured world." With this book as a guide, we will journey together this Lent to (re)discover and develop these traits in our own lives, and in our life together as a faith community.

We would love for you to read along with your Trinity family throughout Lent. Then in worship on Wednesday evenings at 6:30 pm we will devote some time to deeper reflection. If you would like further discussion, we will have a book study group on Wednesday evenings (2/25–3/25) right after worship at approximately 7:00 pm in the Fellowship Hall. As people of faith, our hope is always that God is not done with us. We keep stepping out in faith, trusting that the God is always doing a new thing ... that the Holy Spirit is continually working in us to form us into the people God created us to be. I hope you will join us on this journey of learning, growth, and connection this Lent.

Voting members absent: Deacon Koren Lindley

Non-voting members present: Darrel Presuhn

President Kurt Christian called the meeting to order.

Vice-president Virginia Lemme gave the devotion from 2nd Peter. Believers have a faith like the apostles because we get our faith from Jesus just as they did.

Past-president Tom Farrell led the opening prayer.

Motion by Patti Weber, seconded by Past president Tom Farrell, to amend the agenda to include the report of the Nominating Committee under New Business. Motion carried. Motion by Patti Weber to approve the amended agenda. Motion seconded by Dani Ruhd. Motion carried.

Motion by Eric Anderson, seconded by Patti Weber, to accept the minutes of the December 9, 2025 Council meeting as printed. Motion carried.

Motion by Vice-president Virginia Lemme, seconded by Patti Weber to correct the minutes of the special meeting, December 15, 2025, as follows: under Old Business—Consideration of the 2026 Mission Plan—change the final sentence in section c to read "Pastor Steven Lindley and Deacon Koren Lindley were not present for the vote on the 2026 Mission Plan and the business following. They were inadvertently not called back to the meeting." Motion carried. Motion by Tom Farrell, seconded by Dani Ruhd, to approve the amended minutes. Motion carried.

## FINANCIAL REPORT

Yearly to date statistics include general offering totaling \$354,469.06 and expenses totaling \$416,452.63. \$57,384.11 of the Hannemann Fund will be needed to balance the 2025 Mission Plan. Motion by Patti Weber, seconded by Dani Ruhd, to acknowledge the Financial Report. Motion carried.

## REPORTS

Pastor Steven Lindley submitted a written report. He added that he will not have a visitation week in January. He will resume the monthly visitation week in February.

Deacon Koren Lindley submitted a written report.

President Kurt Christiansen reported

- He thanked the members for their service for the past year.
- He reported that there is a crack in a window in the sacristy. Pastor Steven Lindley added that he noticed a crack in one of the stained glass windows.

Vice-President Virginia Lemme reported

- The menu for the annual meeting is set, and the necessary supplies are in place.

Board of Trustees—Eric Anderson reported

- Office Peeps delivered 40 new padded chairs and 10 new padded arm chairs for the Fellowship Hall. The total cost was \$4,485.88 which was covered by a grant from the Trinity Foundation.
- There was a boiler issue that Sid Gulbranson resolved.
- An \$8,000 donation has been received for replacing the flooring in the offices. Kolorworks will provide cost estimates.
- They plan to replace the window in the southwest corner of the building with cement board painted to match the brick.

Board of Faith Formation—Dani Ruhd reported

- Plans for Bingo Bash on February 1 are progressing.
- Thanks to everyone from her and from Walker.

Board of Deacons—Patti Weber reported

- The *Holden Evening Prayer* will be used for Lenten services.
- The Easter Sunrise Service might not be led by the youth this year.
- She has met with Tonia Meadows, and is making the preparations for Lenten soup suppers. February coffee letters are ready to go.
- The Deacons will have to set the Mission of the Month schedule at their next meeting. They will be concentrating on local recipients for the Jingle Change offering.
- An additional fee of \$49 per month for the new website raised many questions, but no answers yet.
- Vice-president Virginia Lemme has ordered table clothes for the long tables in the Fellowship Hall.

## TEAM BUILDING

Council members were asked to think about the past year and share what was a pleasant surprise for them. They were also asked to share something that disappointed or upset them. Responses included being pleasantly surprised by the generosity of the congregation, being impressed by the faith statements of the confirmands, being surprised by how often they have been thanked for their service, and this being the first year for the office of Past President, they were surprised at the extent of the contributions provided by this office. Disappointments included Trinity's financial position, and wondering why members leave this congregation. Pastor Steven Lindley closed the discussion with a reminder that God redeems bad things though the ways we respond to them.

## OLD BUSINESS

The annual meeting with lunch provided will be held in the Fellowship Hall following the Celebration Service on Sunday, January 18, 2026.

The Council Retreat will be held on Saturday, January 31, 2026, at the Depot from 8:00 a.m. to noon.

## NEW BUSINESS

Vice-president Virginia Lemme presented the report of the Nominating Committee which will appear in the annual report. Motion by Patti Weber, seconded by Past president Tom Farrell, to acknowledge the report. Motion carried.

President Kurt Christiansen thanked everyone for their work over the past year.

Patti Weber moved for adjournment. Motion seconded by Dani Ruhd. Motion carried.

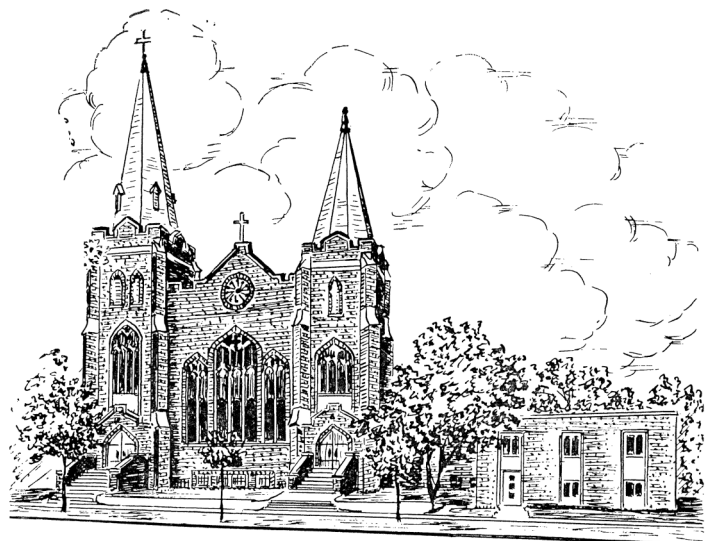

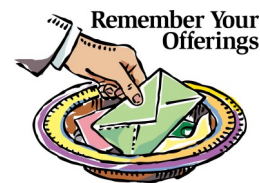
