Hello everyone,

I want to give you an update on everything happening at Trinity.

The Trinity Lutheran Preschool has hired a teacher for the coming year. Beth Himley is the new teacher, and classes will resume this fall as normal. Preschool registration is still open, if you are looking for a preschool option for you child, or if you know someone who is. If you have any questions, please email tlpsmadisonsd@gmail.com and the preschool board will get you taken care of.

With the resignation of Pr. Solveig, we have contracted with a new Interim Pastor. Pastor Bob Hansen will be our new Interim Pastor as of August 1st. Pr. Bob has agreed to be our emergency contact for the month of July, even though he officially starts in August, should any member of our congregation need such services. Pr. Bob will be working ¾ time, spending 2 days a week in the office here in Madison, one day a week working from home, and will also be here on Sundays to lead our services. Pr. Bob comes to us we many years of experience as an Interim Pastor, and I look forward to having him help us through this time of transition.

Along with Pr. Bob, we have hired Deacon Suzanne Hansen to be our temporary Faith Formation Director. Deacon Suzanne is Pr. Bob's wife. Deacon Suzanne, along with volunteers from Trinity, will be leading our

youth programs. She will be putting together the Sunday school and Confirmation programs for the coming school year. Deacon Suzanne will start on July 12th. She will also be working ¾ time, essentially matching schedules with Pr. Bob. Contact information for both Pr. Bob and Deacon Suzanne is available through the church office.

The Call Committee did receive an RMP from the Synod. We have had an initial discussion with the candidate and are in the process of scheduling round two with them. All of the personal details about the candidate are confidential at this point, so if you do ask a member of the Call Committee any questions about them, please understand they are not allowed to give out any more information. I wanted to let you know that the process is moving forward, and we are moving as quickly as we can, while still being thorough and trying to find the best fit for Trinity, not just someone to fill the seat.

Finally, we still have a job opening for Wedding Coordinator at Trinity. If you, or anyone you know of, are interested in this position, please contact the church office.

As of today, 34.4% in the US have been fully vaccinated. It is recommended that congregational singing can resume when this measure is at 50% for a county or municipality.

As of today, Lake County has 3,760 fully vaccinat-

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ed, or 29.4%, 36.6% of those 18 and older and 43.1% of those 65+.

Lake County has nine cases as of this meeting and is categorized as a "Low Level" of Community Transmission. Last month, Lake County was in the "substantial spread" category.

As of today, there were no changes from the SD Synod Office as to their guidelines on resuming full worship.
